She is a member, serving her second term, of the Federal Reserve Bank Healthcare Council, 8th District.



At Express Scripts, Susan was a member of the c-suite and led a \$45B global portfolio focused on driving earnings for shareholders and reducing the cost of medicines by billions of dollars each year. Keenly focused on innovative drug

rebate & formulary strategies, her team globally sourced \$14B of drugs each year, developed the first to market group purchasing organization as a joint venture with Kroger (a Fortune 100 company), and restructuring all provider networks (retail pharmacies, long term care, physicians, infusion). Working closely with pharma and biotech companies, Susan established unique pharma programs in the areas of compliance, patient assistant programs, REMS, and benefit HUBs for limited distribution drugs.

BJC HealthCare During her tenure at BJC, she worked closely with the 12 hospital Boards and the CFO to engineer a 28-month financial turnaround of the System using a 3-point focus: tightly managed cash flow, re-negotiated managed care agreements (reimbursement strategies) and divesting assets, such as a managed Medicaid plan.



Her broad healthcare background and strategic focus assisted UMASS medical school launch a startup PBM, expand Mass Spec lab services to Mexico and China and license biotech discoveries to commercial enterprises.

In addition, Susan continues to consult on complex health care issues with the Ministry of Health, Beijing, Havana Medical School, Cuba and various other global entities. She holds an MBA from Stetson University and a BS in Marketing from the University of Florida.
